### **Financial Report - Discussion**

- Much appreciation to the Hamner family for supporting efforts to enhance "Lookout Point"
- Staffing operating with two lifeguards (thank you!!!), lap swimming has kept steady
- CAPRI Insurance inspection went great
- 1st payment to Sterling Bank went fine, all good
- Brian / Di to explore Trash/Composting/Recycle systems to see if we can improve the look as well as sorting

- Alignment to order a new ice machine
- Holding on Tennis Court light replacement and Ice Cream machine

## **Pool Committee Update**

- No new contracts since last meeting
- Recent Plan / Permit Updates:
  - O'Dell completed the landscape deliverable a study we needed.
  - Grading, drainage, and storm water plan wrapped up, required significant effort.
    Concern was where does the stormwater go?
    - Flattening the hill/removing a significant amount of dirt required a special grading/civil engineering permit as part of the application process. Submitted.
  - On October 8th all information submitted to the County Building department, addressing all open comments; submitted all at once per County request.
    - County tracking towards 30 days finalization on this step after October 13th; so far all going ok
- Bids are due this Friday Oct 22 at 2pm.
- RFP process on Sept 13 the board approved the RFP; on the 22nd; it was published on CSDA websites which made it public.
  - There were ~8 different parties that came to the pool they had seen the announcement. Optimistic that we will receive 3 responses.
- As bids come in, the plan is that Terracon will help to get us to as much of an an apples to apples comparison between the bids as was the intent of the RFP; will discuss further as a board after that has been completed
- Working/discussing "parallel path" efforts as much as possible to keep the effort moving in a timely fashion
- Re-alignment on timing discussion; to hold or push forward given that we may be into June or possibly July? Alignment to push forward.
- Main/Wading Pool discussion
  - Asking contractors to bid on both Wading and the main pool.
  - Timing wise the big pool will be happening first.
  - Have submitted initial set of information to health and building for the wading pool
  - Civil and drainage information covers both pools
  - Should be pretty straightforward and minor on the wading pool.
  - Didn't want to wait on the wading pool to get the "big submission" in with the county.
- We define the responsible qualified bid

### **Open Discussion**

- Search for GM
  - Search continues with discussions/interviews ongoing
  - Working towards making a decision on a candidate by the end of the year; starting either late Dec/early Jan, exact date TBD
  - Once a candidate is on board thank you Di for being open to support during the transition period!!

- Communication
  - Agreement we need to keep communication ongoing with the community while under construction.
- During Construction Process
  - Need to make sure we have coverage at LRD to verify activity, details to be worked out
